Guidelines/Instructions for verification/authentication of online applications by the D.EI.Ed. Institutes for admission to Two Year D.EI.Ed. Course, Session – 2024-2026

In maintenance of what has been stated earlier in our relevant notifications, the following guidelines are to be followed for scrutiny and verification of online applications for admission to Two Year D El Ed Course of 2024-2026 Session.

- 1. Must have studied and passed the Higher Secondary or its equivalent Examination with Bengali / Hindi /Urdu / Nepali /Santhali in Olchiki Script as a compulsory subject, carrying the weightage of 100 marks, for admission to Bengali/Hindi/Urdu/Nepali/Santhali medium Institutions (as the case may be).
- 2. The languages studied by the applicant should be verified. If the language (other than English) does not match the medium of the Institute (as per the list annexed to the notification for admission, dated 16/05/2024), the application shall be rejected outright.
- 3. Must have studied English of 100 marks as the Second/other language in H.S. (10+2) or its equivalent programme.
- 4. Where there are no aggregate marks, 50% / 45% (as the case may be) of the total of the best five scores, excluding EVS (where it is not an elective subject) will be counted for eligibility.
- 4% (i.e. two out of fifty) of the seats shall be earmarked for applicants coming from the Vocational Stream Course (+2 Level) under any recognized Board/University/Council or its equivalent, regardless of categories.
- 6. Such vocational-course-pass-applicants must have studied Bengali/Hindi/Urdu/Nepali/Santhali with English at the H S (10+2) -stage.
- 7. Such vocational-course-pass applicants, however, shall not be eligible for other seats under any condition of backwardness or physical disability.
- 8. A separate merit list for this category shall be prepared and maintained.

9. Calculation of Merit:

- a. The name of the examination should be Higher Secondary or as mentioned in the mark sheet of other recognized Boards or Councils.
- b. The total marks obtained should be the aggregate of the best five, where applicable, including First or Second Language or both* (as the case may be) but excluding EVS (where it is not an elective subject).
 - *If the other language (than that, compulsorily added) comes within the zone of consideration in terms of the norms of the best five, that should also be included as \$1/\$2/\$3/\$4
- **c.** The marks of EVS which is not an Elective Subject should not be taken for calculation of percentage.
- d. For determination of minimum eligibility, the Grand Total marks (where applicable) will be converted into percentages. In such cases, 500 or 450 (as the case may be) out of 1000 (one thousand) shall mean 50 percent or 45 percent respectively.
- e. But in terms of Merit in such cases of full marks of 1000 the best five are to be chosen out of the six subjects (i.e. the marks obtained in the Additional/ Optional subject before deduction may also be considered as \$1/\$2/\$3/\$4, accordingly).
- 10. In case of more than one application, submitted by a single applicant on payment of fees each time separately, in favour of a single listed D.El.Ed. Institute, the verifying/authenticating institute shall invalidate the incomplete one/s and only the complete one will be taken for consideration.
- **11.** The Board will not consider more than one application of an applicant for one listed Institute.
- 12. In-service teachers have been allowed to submit online applications in terms of the notification issued by the Board vide No. 471/WBBPE/D.EI.Ed./2024/78P-05/2024 (Pt-I) dated 12/07/2024 in compliance with the Order of the Hon'ble High court, Calcutta dated 11/07/2024 and subsequent orders. No such norms as stated above (sl no. 1 to 11) to be followed in respect of the In-Service Primary School Teachers recruited in the year 2009 and appointed after 2012 onwards.

Such teachers will have to be duly deputed by the competent authority. The applications of the In-Service teachers will not be accepted without the recommendation of the Chairman, DPSC/PSC or D.I./s (PE) for admission to the course.

They should produce the recommendation/Order for deputation at the time of admission.

13. Age: There shall be no lower age limit.

Upper Age limit as on the first day of July of the year of Notification for such admission shall be 35 Years for General Category candidates, 40 Years for SC and ST candidates, 38 Years for OBC-A & OBC-B candidates, while for PHcandidates it shall be 45 years.

The upper age limit for an Ex-Serviceman Applicant shall be 55 Years, whereas in case of an in-service primary school teacher, there shall be no such upper age limit, if he/she is duly recommended by the concerned Chairman/chairperson of the DPSC/PSC or D.I. of Schools (PE).

The Heads of the Institutions will verify and scrutinize the particulars submitted by the candidates <u>on and from 22/08/2024 to 28/08/2024</u>. They will adjudicate all the applications online through such scrutiny and verification. Next, they will submit the application forms by clicking on the "**submit**" button for the next course of action by Board.

Note: The fresher candidates (pre-service), who applied for admission to Two Year D.El.Ed Course, Session – 2024-2026, will only be admitted in the seats granted to the Institutes by the NCTE and affiliated to WBBPE in accordance with the recognition and affiliation norms laid down in the Recognition Rules, 2014 of the ERC, NCTE. Hence, the seat for the In-Service Primary School Teachers will have to be extended as per the requirement, i.e. the institute-wise valid applications submitted by the intending primary school teachers recruited in the year 2009 & appointed after 2012 & onwards. However, the Heads of the Institutions are further instructed that the applications submitted online by the In-Service Primary School Teachers will not be rejected on any way. Only the list, institute wise number of In-Service Primary School Teachers, those who have applied for admission in the session 2024-2024 as per the above Court Order, will be provided through institute log-in for admission to the Two-Year D.El.Ed. Course, session 2024-2026 after having proper verification report from the District Inspector of Schools (PE) concerned.

14. If a candidate is validated or rejected by the Institute without proper verification and scrutiny of documents, the entire responsibility of such validation or rejection shall rest upon the authority of the Institution.

The Board will prepare the merit list only for the fresher candidates on the basis of the list of the candidates verified/authenticated by the institute and, thereafter forward the approved list/s online to the institutes for admission on and from <u>28th August, 2024</u>.

However, if the information/credentials of any authenticated/validated candidate, found deficient after further verification at any stage of the subsequent verification or during the course, his/her candidature shall be cancelled by the Board.

15. The institutions will intimate all the selected candidates from the approved merit lists serially through SMS/WhatsApp/E-mail.
